Junction Funhouse Is a-MAZE-ing For Kids Of All Ages

***At EnterTRAINment Junction -
You've Got To See It To Believe It!***

CINCINNATI, OH -- Remember the excitement of an amusement park funhouse?

Those days are back again at EnterTRAINment Junction, complete with trick mirrors, spinning black holes, hurricane rooms and surprises behind every door.

It called Junction Funhouse, and it's all part of the total family entertainment experience awaiting kids, parents and grandparents at the new EnterTRAINment Junction, opening for preview weekends Friday, July 18. Daily Operations begin August 1.

Kids' will be aMAZEd and adults will relive the fun of their youth in the 5,000 square-foot Junction Funhouse "walk-through," where the senses come alive in a world of scenic design, sounds, sensory elements and theatrical lighting.

Visitors start their Junction Funhouse journey through a grungy alleyway right out of a Hollywood backlot with a dilapidated carriage, scattered barrels and worn cargo crates. They proceed past an old, abandoned Victorian house to another brick alley, then suddenly they are confronted with an infinity mirror maze both confounding and

disorienting. Next is a vortex tunnel with a room spinning out of kilter, then a dark hallway where unseen forces whisper into visitors' ears.

The journey continues into a black-lit room with 3-D clowns ushering visitors into a hazardous waste dump, where chain link fences begin and end seemingly in no certain order. Then comes the curtain chamber where visitors have to find their way out, right into a dark claustrophobic hallway where visitors have to squeeze through air-filled bags. And, finally, visitors end in a hurricane room, where wind howls, walls shake, objects fly and the building sounds as if, at any moment, it could be torn apart at the seams.

Junction Funhouse runs January-August. Admission is \$6. In the fall, the walk-through experience will be Halloween themed, and in the winter it will be themed for a special Christmastime celebration.

EnterTRAINment Junction is open for preview weekends Friday-Saturday-Sunday, July 18-19-20 and July 25-26-27. Daily operations begin with a Grand Opening celebration Friday August 1. Preview weekend hours are 10 a.m.-7 p.m., Fridays and Saturday, noon-6 p.m. Sundays. When the EnterTRAINment Junction goes to a seven day a week operation August 1, hours are 10 a.m.-7 p.m. Mon.-Sat., noon-6 p.m. Sunday. (Closed Easter Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.)

Located in suburban West Chester, EnterTRAINment Junction is the **ONLY** railroad-themed family entertainment center on the planet! The new, \$10 million project features an incredible 80,000 square-feet of unmatched family fun, all under one roof.
